any storm related debris so it can be reached by the contractor. Each landowner must sign a waiver relieving the parish of any liability. The debris must be staged by the homeowner as close to the right-of-way as possible. The grab trucks will only pick up debris near the right-of-way. Additionally, tree removal contractors are allowed to place storm related tree debris on the right-of-way for pickup by the debris pickup contractor.
