



Separating Your Debris

Failure to follow these guidelines will result in your waste not being picked up.

Ordinance 2004-O-37 governs the removal of roadside debris, which is located on our website at www.vppj.org.

The three categories of debris will be removed by separate trucks.

ROADSIDE DEBRIS

ONLY THESE THREE CATEGORIES OF DEBRIS ARE ALLOWED ALONG THE ROADSIDE.

CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS

Sheetrock/Drywall Plaster
Lumber Insulation
Wood Fencing Brick
Full Length Mirror Plumbing

YARD WASTE

Small Branches Bagged Leaves Plant Shrubs
Logs/Limbs no longer than 6 ft. and 18 in. diameter

OTHER ROADSIDE

(Piled separately from Construction & Yard)

Furniture Carpet
Mattresses Large Plastic Items
Vacuum Cleaners Television
Wading Pools (Rolled & Taped)
Air Conditioners (Window Units Only-no freon)
Power Wheels (No Batteries)

DEBRIS SEPARATION: Separate debris into six categories shown below.

DO NOT STACK OR LEAN: Placing debris near or on trees, poles, under powerlines or other structures make removal difficult. This includes fire hydrants & meters.

UNSURE WHERE TO PLACE DEBRIS? All roadside debris must be placed as close to the roadside as possible without blocking the roadway or drainage. No closer than 6 ft from any obstruction.

Any debris generated by contractors should be picked up as responsibility of the contractor. Remove and bring to Solid Waste for disposal.

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS (Placed in 96-Gallon Waste Container)

Food Waste
Small Boxes
Toys
Clothes
Tupperware
Dishes/Pots/Pans
Curtain/Blinds
Sheets/Bedding/Towels
Small Appliances
***Any items listed under "ROADSIDE DEBRIS" that can fit in a 96-Gallon Waste Container must be placed in the container.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS (Not picked up by VPPJ)

White Goods (No Freon/Compacitors)
Waste Tires
Large Trees
Fully Demolished Homes
Large Appliance Boxes

UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

Aerosols Paint
Acids Roofing Shingles Batteries
Furniture Polish/Wax
Pest/Herb/Instecides
Used Oil/Anti-Freeze, Etc.
***Unacceptable waste items may be delivered to the landfill during the VPPJ Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day.

Zone 1 pickup is on the 1st of each month.

Zone 2 pickup is on the 11th of each month.

Zone 3 pickup is on the 21st of each month.

Districts 1, 2, 10, 12, 14 are in **Zone 1**.

Districts 5, 9A (west of river), 11, 13 are in **Zone 2**.

Districts 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9B (east of river) are in **Zone 3**.

NOTE: District 9 is divided into 9A and 9B. 9A is the west side of the river and 9B is the east side of the river.
